Jiayu Pass and Dunhuang (3 - day program)

Jiayu Pass is the first pass at the west end of the Great Wall of China, and Mogao Grottoes is the best known Chinese Buddhist Grottoes. You will get the chance to experience the two historic treasures which were classified as World Heritage by UNESO.



LZU Ranking

It is indicated that LZU has published 13,010 papers in SCI, and ranks in the 91th in the world and the 18th among Chinese universities (Nature, May, 2019).



For students from non-partner universities of Lanzhou University, a tuition of 600USD will be charged.
