- Symbols of Canada, Saskatchewan, & Regina

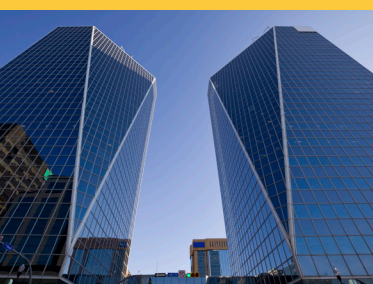
For almost 60% of the course, you will have live classes with an instructor and live conversation and culture sessions with University of Regina students. With the virtual local contact add-on, you will also have the chance to meet virtually with a local Regina resident for 90 minutes a week. The rest of the course will be delivered through non-live technology-enabled activities. Class times accommodate time differences between Canada and Japan. Live sessions will be between 8:30 am and 12:30 pm Japanese time.
